## Bachelor's Degrees

With an associate degree or 60 hours of transferable college credit, you can advance to a bachelor's degree at FSCJ. We offer Bachelor of Applied Science (B.A.S.) and Bachelor of Science (B.S.) degrees in a variety of relevant and exciting areas, as well as a Bachelor of Science in Nursing (B.S.N.). These upper-level degrees increase your knowledge and experience in your program of study while providing the management, leadership, critical analysis, and communication skills that will advance you professionally and enrich you personally. Our bachelor's degrees are designed not only to give you an exceptional education but also to provide a skilled workforce that meets the needs of our community. Also, because tuition costs at FSCJ are considerably less than you will find for a comparable education in the area, the money you save could go toward graduate school.

### Bachelor's Degree Admissions Requirements

To meet the minimum requirement for acceptance to bachelor's degrees at Florida State College at Jacksonville, students must:

1. Meet the General Admissions Eligibility Criteria.
2. Meet the admissions requirements for upper division college credit programs:
  1. Must have earned an Associate in Science (A.S.), Associate in Arts (A.A.), or a minimum of 60 hours of transferable college credit or higher degree from a regionally accredited college or university with a GPA of 2.0 or above. The institution must have been regionally accredited when the degree or credits were awarded.
  2. Must have met all requirements for college preparatory work.
  3. **Selective Admissions:** All upper-division programs have additional admissions requirements established by the College administration, Florida Statutes, and/or State Board of Education rules.
    1. Additional requirements may include a higher grade-point-average requirement;
    2. Admissions requirements are published on the program curriculum pages;
    3. In compliance with state law, public Florida state or community college graduates are eligible for priority admissions to upper-division programs.
  4. **Provisional Upper Division Admission:** Students who do not meet all the requirements for an upper division baccalaureate program may be provisionally admitted to the baccalaureate program with the approval of the appropriate dean or dean's designee.
    1. Students will be informed of the conditions required for full admission when provisionally admitted.
    2. Students must meet conditions for full admission within one semester from the date of provisional admission.
    3. Students admitted provisionally to baccalaureate programs must, as a priority, enroll in coursework that will fulfill conditions for full admission status to their intended program of study during the term of provisional admission.
    4. Requests for enrollment in upper division courses by provisionally admitted students must be considered and approved by special exception by the appropriate dean or the dean's designee.
    5. When the conditions for full admission have been satisfied, the hold on enrollment in upper-division courses may be lifted by the appropriate dean or dean's designee.
    6. Students participating in college preparatory (remedial) coursework are ineligible for provisional admission.
  5. **Non-Degree Seeking Upper Division Students:** Non-degree-seeking students may be admitted to enroll in courses for which the student meets all program requirements and course prerequisites. Enrollment in upper division courses requires submission of all postsecondary transcripts before registration and the approval of the appropriate dean or dean's designee.

All bachelor's degree programs have additional admissions requirements established by the College administration, Florida Statutes, and/or State Board of Education Rules. Admissions requirements are published on the program curriculum pages.

### General Education Requirements

Students select general education courses from the five broad liberal arts discipline areas: communication, humanities, mathematics, natural sciences, and social/behavioral sciences. At least one course in each of the five discipline areas shall be identified as a state core course option per Florida State Statute 1007.25(3). Courses identified with an asterisk (\*) are designated as state core courses and are accepted as general education at all state colleges and universities.

### Foreign Language Requirement for Baccalaureate Degree

Baccalaureate degree-seeking students must meet a foreign language requirement before graduation. Students may fulfill the requirement by completing eight semester hours of the same foreign language or sign language. Alternative options that will be considered include the following:

Successful completion of two sequential high school credits in one foreign language as listed in Florida Statute 1007.262 and DOE Board Rule 6A.10.02412. The student is responsible for sending official high school transcripts to the Registrar's Office for evaluation.

Submitting an English-translated high school course-by-course transcript from a country of origin. Exit test scores or certificates are not acceptable. Students must have an English translation performed, at the student's expense, by a member of the National Association of Credential Evaluation Services (NACES). Visit the NACES website for a list of NACES members. Examples of acceptable services are Josef Silny & Associates and World Education Services.

Also, appropriate College Level Examination Program (CLEP) level one and two scores in French, German, and Spanish will be accepted.

Courses in American Sign Language (ASL 1140 and ASL 1150), Chinese (CHI 1120 and CHI 1121), French (FRE 1120 and FRE 1121), French Conversation (FRE 2210 and FRE 2211), German (GER 1120 and GER 1121), German Intermediate (GER 2200 and GER 2201), Latin (LAT 1120 and LAT 1121), Spanish (SPN 1120 and SPN 1121), Spanish Conversation (SPN 2210 and SPN 2211), and Spanish Intermediate (SPN 2200 and SPN 2201) fulfill this eight credit hour requirement. Students may use the ASL prefix course combination to satisfy the college's foreign language requirements.

## Writing and Mathematical Skills Requirement

The Florida State Board of Education Rule regarding the required writing and mathematical skills was revised in December 2005. 6A-10.030 specifies the policies and procedures for implementing the requirement.

## Bachelor's Degree Graduation Requirements

To receive a bachelor's degree, students must:

1. Fulfill all academic requirements for the chosen program of study as outlined in the Florida State College at Jacksonville catalog and curriculum.
2. Earn minimum prescribed semester hours for the selected bachelor's degree with at least a 2.0 (C) on a 4.0 scale for an all-college cumulative grade point average. This includes Florida State College at Jacksonville college-credit semester hours and transferred credits (excluding developmental education) in lower- and upper-division courses.
3. Earn at least a C in each course used to satisfy the General Education Requirements and any other area designated with a C or higher in each course.
4. Earn a minimum of 25 percent of all credits used to satisfy the baccalaureate degree course requirements from Florida State College at Jacksonville (for example, a minimum of 30 credits for a 120-credit bachelor's degree). Credit by examination and credit for prior learning do not count toward this residency requirement.
5. Fulfill the 36-college credit Florida General Education Requirements (note: 45 semester hours of required General Education for the B.S.N. degree and 51 semester hours of required General Education for the Bachelor of Science in Biomedical Sciences degree), including the required core course options as listed in s. 1007.25(3), Florida Statute, and State Board Rule 6A.14.0303, Florida Administrative Code.
6. Demonstrated competency in civic literacy in accordance with s. 1007.25, Florida Statutes, and State Board of Education Rule 6A-10.02413, Florida Administrative Code. Per guidelines established by Senate Bill 1108, competency is demonstrated by completing one of two civic literacy courses (AMH2020 or POS2041) with a grade of C or higher AND by achieving a passing score on a state-approved assessment.
7. Fulfill the Foreign Language requirement.
8. Fulfill all obligations, financial or otherwise, to the College before graduation.

**Note: Students are cautioned to pay particular attention to the following statements.**

- A student's graduation date will be the date of the end of the College term in which the student has fulfilled all academic requirements. (The removal of an incomplete grade does not affect students' graduation dates, since the grade change is effective at the end of the term in which the incomplete grade was assigned rather than the term in which the incomplete work was made up.)
- Students who enter under the (2024/2025) catalog will be assigned to the degree or certificate requirements in effect during the 2024/2025 academic year. The student's assigned catalog year will remain in effect as long as the student maintains continuous enrollment. Changes to requirements as mandated by law or by rule of the District Board of Trustees may supersede this provision.
- Many courses in this catalog have prerequisite requirements and/or corequisite courses listed in the course descriptions. Students are advised to be guided by these requirements.

## DRAFT Mathematics Pathways

Per the requirements of \*Senate Bill 366, Mathematics Pathways were created to facilitate the seamless transfer of credits, reduce excess credit hours, and ensure that students throughout Florida's public colleges and universities take the math courses needed for their future careers. The three mathematics pathways include Algebra Through Calculus, Statistical Reasoning, and Mathematical Thinking in Context. Each pathway consists of a general education core math course that serves as the mathematical starting point for students in a specific academic program.

While Associate in Science students will typically take one math course, Associate in Arts and Bachelor's students will complete at least two math courses. Depending on their program of study, students may be required to take additional math courses.

Below is a description of the three mathematics pathways and their learning outcomes. Listed also are the general education core and non-core math courses for each pathway. ## Algebra Through Calculus

### Pathway Description

This pathway is intended for students whose academic program requires a foundation of algebra, followed by a sequence of courses that may lead to calculus.

### Learning Outcomes

Demonstrate the knowledge of various algebraic relationships and their application.

- Execute appropriate mathematical modeling techniques for solving application problems and interpreting results of solutions.
- Develop graphical models using algebraic and problem-solving techniques.

## Statistical Reasoning Pathway

### Pathway Description

This pathway is intended for students whose academic program requires a foundation in descriptive statistics, probability, and inferential statistics to facilitate the use and interpretation of data.

### Learning Outcomes

Students will analyze data using graphical and numerical methods to study patterns and departures from patterns, using appropriate technology as needed.

- Students will critically evaluate a data-collection plan to answer a given research question.
- Students will use probability concepts and simulation.
- Students will use statistical models to draw conclusions from data.
- Students will perform correlation and regression analyses.
- Students will apply statistical reasoning and data analysis to real-world or major-specific examples.

## Mathematical Thinking in Context Pathway

### Pathway Description

This pathway is intended for students in the broadest range of programs of study. In this pathway, students will explore a variety of mathematical concepts utilizing multiple ways of thinking to formulate and solve problems in context.

### Learning Outcomes

Determine efficient means of solving a problem through the investigation of multiple mathematical models.

- Apply logic in contextual situations to formulate and determine the validity of logical statements using a variety of methods.
- Apply mathematical concepts visually and contextually to represent, interpret and reason about geometric figures.
- Apply mathematical models to civically contextual situations (e.g., stocks, finance, voting, population dynamics, etc.).
- Recognize the characteristics of numbers and utilize numbers along with their operations appropriately in context.
- Organize, visualize and model data in a meaningful way.
- Analyze and interpret representations of data to draw reasonable conclusions.
- Engage in ways of thinking that may involve sample size, counting strategies, chance, ratios and proportions.

#### Overview

##### Mission/Purpose

The Associate in Arts (A.A.) degree is for students who seek a general degree program which allows the freedom to explore a broad array of

intellectual fields and interests while selecting from a wide variety of general education and elective course options. The program provides a broad range of educational opportunities and directly challenges students to assume responsibility for their own education goals.

## **Program Overview**

The program is specifically intended to meet the requirements of students interested in transferring to one of Florida's many public colleges or universities or continuing to pursue a four-year bachelor's degree at Florida State College at Jacksonville. Students are encouraged to determine which upper-division major they plan to pursue and advised to follow the state standard for their specific degree major. Students should also plan to meet with an Advisor to assist them in selecting general education courses and the best recommended electives for their advising track in order to best compliment their selected upper-division major.

Students should be aware of the specific requirements of the Associate in Arts degree imposed by state of Florida regulations and laws and the requirements established by the Southern Associate of Colleges and Schools as well as Florida's Gordon Rule.

Per Florida State Statute 1007.23(3):

"To improve articulation and reduce excess credit hours, beginning with students initially entering a Florida College System institution in 2013-2014 and thereafter, the articulation agreement must require each student who is seeking an associate in arts degree to indicate a baccalaureate degree program offered by an institution of interest by the time the student earns 30 semester hours. The institution in which the student is enrolled shall inform the student of the prerequisites for the baccalaureate degree program offered by an institution of interest."

## **General Education Paradigm/Philosophy**

General Education course selections at Florida State College at Jacksonville prepare students to become thoughtful, generative learners. Through exploring broad areas of knowledge - the human condition, the global and historical, the cultural and aesthetic, and the communicative, mathematical, scientific, and technological - students will develop the knowledge bases, and intellectual competencies, and be exposed to the values requisite for participating responsibly in, and adapting to, a complex and diverse world.

In accordance with Florida Statute 1007.25, students initially entering a Florida College System institution in 2014-2015 and thereafter who wish to obtain an Associate of Arts degree must demonstrate competency in a foreign language pursuant to guidelines set in Florida Statute 1007.262. Competency is demonstrated by foreign language proficiency (at the intermediate level) equivalent to 2-years in high school or a sequence of two college credit courses in a single foreign language.

Note: Per Florida Statute 1007.2615(2)(b), students may use the ASL prefix coursework combination to satisfy the foreign language requirements of the College; however, the ASL prefix coursework may not count toward satisfying the foreign language requirements of the intended transfer major at state universities and postsecondary institutions outside of Florida.

A minimum grade of C or higher is required to satisfy the College's foreign language coursework graduation requirement.
